#### **ECONOMIC HEADLINES**


- The U.S. and China have agreed to suspend most tariffs on each other's goods for 90 days.
- <u>The Federal Reserve made no change to interest rates</u>, but did note in their statement that "the risks of higher unemployment and higher inflation have risen."
- All three major stock averages fell slightly last week.
- · Growth in the services sector of the economy rose in April.
- The U.S. trade deficit in goods and services rose to a record \$140.5 billion in March.
- Some U.S. manufacturers are seeing increased orders because of companies avoiding the new tariffs.
- A recent CNBC survey found that 65% of respondents said the Fed will cut rates this year.
- <u>Americans' views on their current and future financial situations</u>, as well as their expectations for future earnings and income, soured in April.
- Major U.S. employers <u>are slowing or pausing hiring</u> to cut costs amid economic uncertainty.
- 83% of consumers surveyed by Intuit Credit Karma said that if their financial situation worsens in the coming months, they will strongly consider <u>cutting back on their non-essential spending</u>.
- The chairman of the House tax committee warned lawmakers that cap of state and local tax deductions may be increased, <u>but it's not going away</u>.
- Treasury Secretary Bessent said President Trump's trade policies should be viewed as one leg of a three-pronged vision, <u>along with tax cuts and deregulation</u>.
- The International Monetary Fund has issued their World Economic Outlook.
- According to a majority of FX strategists surveyed by Reuters, concerns are mounting <u>about the U.S. dollar's</u> safe haven appeal.

#### HOUSING NEWS

- According to a Gallup survey, Americans believe real estate is the best long-term investment.
- Applications for a mortgage to purchase a home <u>rose 11% for the week</u> and were 13% higher than the same week one year ago.
- The average 30-year mortgage rates was unchanged last week.
- More renters are <u>choosing to stay in their apartments</u> when their leases are up.
- <u>Here's where home prices</u> are rising and falling the most according to Intercontinental Exchange.
- Home prices are still rising by double-digits in some markets.
- A new report from NAR suggests home staging can help sell a home faster and for more money.
- · According to Sherwin-Williams, neutral colors don't always have to be your go-to in home staging.

- New York's state budget <u>has been passed</u>.
